

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Weston Airport is a privately owned and licensed airfield that provides airport services to executive aircraft owners and operators, and to flight training schools.

Weston Airport is committed to ensuring that all of its operations and those of all businesses, aircraft operators, contractors, and suppliers that operate at, and use Weston Airport are carried out in an environmentally responsible manner.

Weston Airport identified the need to protect the nearby River Liffey from the possibility of pollution resulting from any operations at Weston Airport. Procedures have been introduced to ensure that such pollution does not occur. These procedures will be the subject of regular reviews to assure their effectiveness. We will install additional surface drain interceptors to further improve the protection of the Liffey.

Weston Airport recognises the noise impact that aircraft operating out of, and visiting Weston Airport has on nearby communities. We have introduced noise abatement procedures, complaint procedures, deployed appropriate technology, and introduced land use measures to minimise those impacts. We will continue to review all procedures with a view to improving our noise abatement performance.

We have carried out a survey of all aircraft operators based at the airport. This survey enabled us to determine their views and understanding of noise pollution and noise abatement procedures. We established a community liaison group with a view to identifying, and addressing community concerns. Weston Airport will continue in its efforts to positively engage with local communities with regards to all environmental protection issues.

We will continue to communicate with, listen to, and be responsive to our employees, customers, neighbours, and the relevant authorities, with regards to our environment protection responsibilities. We will comply with all applicable environmental regulations, and will implement programmes and procedures to ensure continued compliance.

Weston Airport recognises that the airport site, with its built environment and open green spaces is a showcase of our image and attitude in relation to the environment. We will manage the complete site in an ecologically sound manner, protecting soil and groundwater, promoting plant life, while protecting and creating habitat for wildlife consistent with the safe operation of the airport.

Weston Airport is implementing an environmental management system to formalise all current and future environmental management initiatives. The environmental management system incorporates objectives, targets, monitoring procedures, and programmes to reduce all environmental effects and impacts resulting from our operations. As part of this process we have appointed an environmental officer and established a noise committee. Our employees are aware of, and are involved in the implementation of our environmental management system. Staff training needs have been identified and training has been provided. Staff training and development will be an ongoing process.

As part of its involvement in the Green Dragon Programme, Weston Airport has committed to continual environmental improvement and independent environmental audits every two years.
